

Tutorial - Beaded Donut - part 1
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I recommend watching your tutorial directly on your computer screen

String 44 R8 and go back through the first R8 to form a loop.



Pick up one R11B, one R15 and one R11B, skip one R8 and go through the next R8 on the circle. Pick up one R8, skip one R8 and go through the next R8 on the circle. Pull tightly at each step and go around the entire circle.



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Finish the circle going back through the first R8 and the first R11B added (see photo).

Pull tightly.



Continue in mixed Herringbone and peyote stitch with the following sequence:
Pick up two R11B, go through the second R11B added in row 1 (see photo).
Pick up one R11A, go through the next R8.
Pick up one R11A, go through the next R11B.
Tighten the beads.



Repeat the sequence throughout the entire circle.
Finish the row by going through the two R11B (see photo) and tighten.

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Pick up one R11B, go through the following R11B.
Pick up one D11A, go through the following R11A.
Pick up one D11A, go through the following R11A.
Pick up one D11A, go through the following R11B.
Repeat this sequence and finish as shown in the photo.

Tighten the beads.



Work in peyote stitch with D11B.



Work in peyote stitch, alternating the following bead sequence: one D11A, one D11A, one D11A, three R11B.
Repeat around the entire row and tighten the beads at each step.
Tighten the beads at each step as shown.

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	<p>Pick up one R15 and go through the next bead. When at the picot of three R11B, go through them without adding any bead (see photo). Tighten the beads at each step.</p>
	<p>Pull the thread through the work up to the first R8 beads row and go through the first two rows again to reinforce it. Your needle should exit an R8 bead from the first circle.</p>
