a. Réponse attendue :

*Protection of turtles on Kenyan shores.*

b. Réponses attendues :

*Endangered by mass tourism, tourist resorts / no litter in the water, no bright lights on the beaches, no beach furniture on the sand, no motorised beach vehicles, eco-friendly marine tour operators.*

c. Cette question permet de commencer le travail sur les relatives à partir d'une observation en contexte.

Propositions à relever :

*“resorts that have responsible beachfront management practice” (l.10-11)*

*“bright lights that face the beach” (l.11-12)*

→ relatives: “**that**” refers to “resorts” and “bright lights”

*“so that it does not present obstacles” (l.19)*

→ “**so that**” is an expression used to express the possibility of a goal.
