«Peau d'âme» Shawl

A veil of sweetness!



Materials → * Circular needles US size 2

*2 Skeins (200m each one (218 yards each one) of pink cashmere and silk from Isatinctoria shop (on alittlemarket website) You need approx, a total of 436 yds of yarns.

*2 stiches markers

Abbreviations $\rightarrow k - knit$

SM – slip marker

PM- place marker

s – stich

p – purl

R- Row

yo- yarn over

k2tog : knit 2 stiches together

s : stich

M: marker

*Cast on 5 stiches

* $Row1 \rightarrow k1-yo-k1-yo-PM-k1-PM-yo-k1-yo-k1$

*Row 2 and all even rows - p1-yo- purl all stiches -yo-p1

* $\underline{Row \ 3} \rightarrow k1$ -yo-knit all stiches-yo-SM-k1-SM-yo-knit all stiches-yo-k1

*Repeat rows 2 et 3 until the end of the first skein (200m of yarn or 218 yds of yarn)

You must have a number of odd stiches on your needles, on each side of your stiches markers (ex : 137s-M-1m-M-137s)

Lace:

Rg A. (Right Side): k1 *yo- k2tog * repeat from * to * until the first stich marker ,yo ,SM-k1-SM-yo * k2tog-yo* repeat from * to * until 1 m de la fin du rang ,et terminer par 1 m end

Rg B: (Wrong Side): repeat like all even rows of the beginning

Repeat 1 more time the rows A et B, then knit 3 stockinette rows, increasing in the beginning and the end of right AND wrong side: k1 (or p1) -yo- knit all stiches - yo-k1 (or p1)

Repeat rows A and B + the 3 stockinette rows 4 more times, and don't forget you must have an odd number stiches on your needles on each side of your stiches markers, in the beginning of each lace row

Bind off loosely \rightarrow k1 – *k1 – pass left hand needle in the 2 knitted stiches and k2tog *, repeat from * to the end.

Wet block your shawl! (essential!)
