



Vignobles Dorneau

Presentation and Philosophy :

The property has been owned by the Dorneau family for several generations, dating back to 1870.

Covering an area of 25 hectares, it is composed of several vineyards:

- The Château la Croix, property of origin, of 10 hectares in Fronsac*
- The Château Roulet, acquired in 1949, of 2.50 hectares in Canon Fronsac*
- The Château Pontus, bought in 1960 from 10 hectares in Fronsac*
- As well as some parcels located in Bordeaux appellation.*

Currently managed by Patrick and Alice Dorneau, the farm turned to truffle farming in 2008, opening the door to an oenotouristic activity combining truffles and wines. The way in which vineyards are managed, both in terms of cultivation and in the making of wines, is guided only by one objective of quality. A permanent questioning based on the association of new technologies with the experience of the tradition leads today to the elaboration of great wines. The passion for this soil so privileged leads to respect and be attentive to the way of driving the vineyard. Are preferred the manual work for the vine and mechanical for the soil

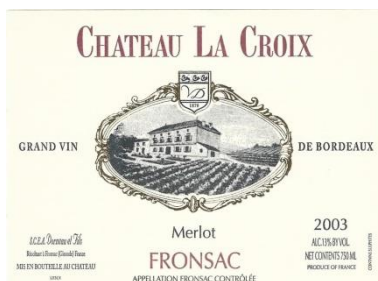
The wines of the winery :

- **Château Roulet Canon Fronsac :** *"A bright ruby wine, which opens on ripe red and black fruits, vanilla and some minty shades. The palate, full and concentrated, is well built around full-bodied tannins and a marked oak. "*
- **Château La Croix Fronsac :** *«Wine with deep purple color. Expressive nose, fruity and vinous. Concentrated mouth, sweet and round tannins with fine woody and spicy »*



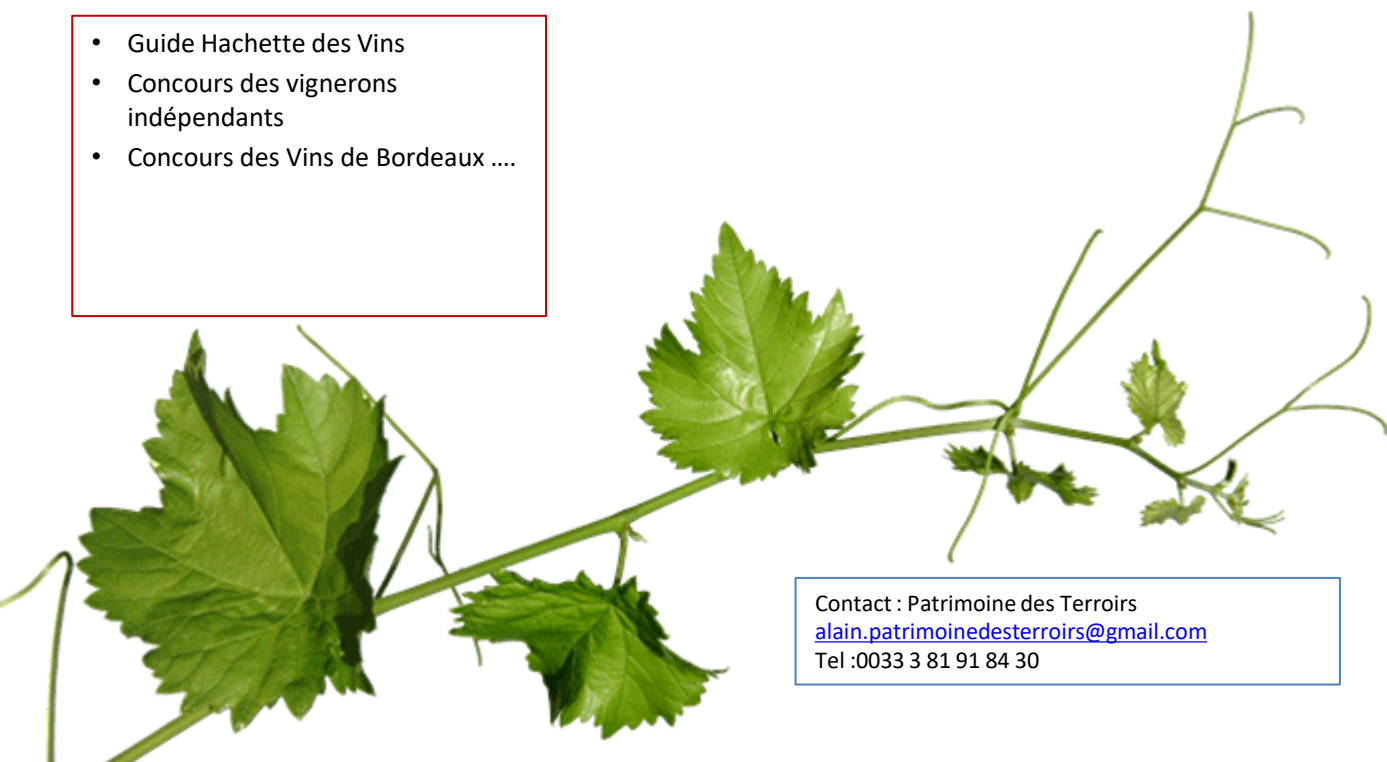
