

Bonnet Paddy

Adult size : 57/60cm hat size.

Material :

2 skeins of [Nebula](#)

Circular needles 4mm

1 stitch marker

1 tapestry needle.



Gauge : 22 stitches/30 rows.

Abbreviations :

k : knit

p : purl

m1 : make 1 increase ([have a look here for help](#))

... repeat the motive from*to* as much as necessary

D : decrease: either 3 stitches knit together or 3 stitches purl together according to stitches to be knit in your work. Every decrease gives 2 stitches less.

st: stitch

Work :

Cast on 80 st, put the stitch marker and knit in ribs 1/1:

Round : *k1 ,p1 *. Repeat this round up to 2.5cm.

Do a round of increase:

m1, (p1, k1) x2, p1, m1, (p1, k1) x2, p1, 96 st.

Then repeat the 2 following rounds (moss stitch) until 14cm of total height :

Round 1 : *p, k*

Round 2 : *k, p*

For the decreases, adapt the decrease to the point (if the stitch which you have needs to be knit, knit 3 stitches together; if it is a stitch to purl, purl 3 stitches together)

Decrease 1 : *13 st moss stitch, D* 84 st

Do 3 rounds in moss stitch.

Decrease 2 : *11 st moss stitch, D* 72 st

Do 3 rounds in moss stitch.

Decrease 3 : *9 st moss stitch, D* 60 st

Do 3 rounds in moss stitch.

Decrease 4 : *7 st moss stitch, D* 48 st

Do 3 rounds in moss stitch.

Decrease 5 : *5 st moss stitch, D* 36 st

Do 1 round in moss stitch.

Knit 2 together all the st.

Fix the top of the hat, bring in the threads, cut them short, it's done !
