

# Cosy Shawl

This shawl is simple, easy to knit, it does not require any specific point and allows to make a work of large size easily.

Size of the shawl : 84cm/200cm

Material :

3 balls of [Mohair Lady Print](#), Schoppel Wolle

or 4 balls of [Soprane](#), Cheval Blanc (knit with 2 threads at the same time)

circular needles 7mm with a cable of 80cm minimum.

2 stitch markers .A row counter.

Beads, a fine hook (0.6 or 0.75mm), to finish the edge.

Points :

st : stitch

M : stitch marker

k : knit

p: purl

m1 : increase 1 stitch

P2tog : purl 2 together

SKP : slip 1, knit 1 , pass over.

YO : yarn over

R : row

\*....\* : repeat the pattern between \*....\* as many time as it's necessary



## Work :

Cast on 3 stitches. Knit 6 rows (but not turn the work after the last row). Make a rotation of the work of 90 ° and knit 3 stitches in the highly-rated of the bars of garter stitch (we obtain 6 stitches). Make again a rotation of 90 ° of your work clockwise, knit 3 stitches in the row of assembly. We obtain 9 stitches.

R69: k3, m1, (SKP, Yo) x82, m1, k3 (172st)

R70 (wrong side row): k3, p1, (P2tog, Yo) x82 p1, k3 (172st)

R71: k3, m1, k1 (SKP, Yo) x82, k1, m1, k3(174st)

R72 (wrong side row): k3, p2, (P2tog, Yo) x82, p2, k3 (174st)

R73: k3, m1, k82, m1, M k4 M, m1, k82, m1, k3 (178st)

Do the row 116.

R117 : knit the first stitch, insert a bead in this stitch, then bind off flexibly 4 stitches. Begin again by following this rhythm (insert a bead, bind off 4st...) up to the front last stitch. Insert a bead and bind off the last stitch. Bring in the threads, cut them short.

(*you can have a look there to insert beads*)

If you want to enlarge this shawl, you can easily do it:

Repeat the rows 89 à 92 three times (By not taking into account repetitions and numbers of stitches indicated of course!), then do 24 rows in repeating these 2 following rows :

R1 : k3, m1, kX, m1, M k4 M, m1, kX, m1, k3 (X st)

R2 : k3, pX, k3

(X represent the number of stitches, it changes according to your progress.)
